


Standards Process

- Proposal acceptance
- Draft standard
- comment by members
- Resolve all comments
- Vote on standard







Every 5 years

- Reaffirm
- Revise
- Withdraw

Must achieve consensus







World Wide Web Consortium

- □ W3C
- Ad hoc process
- No members
- Publish Idea
- Ask for comments
 - Request for comments RFC
 - When no more comments
 - Implement





Other groups

- Gather
- Propose idea
- Develop guidelines
 - Protocol
 - Syntax
 - Method
- Ask others to join
- Faster, consensus not needed
